- Set profile settings to private
- Don't publish personal information such as address and phone number anywhere online
- Turn off location tracking
- Use 'strong' passwords that are a mix of letters, numbers and symbols, and are at least seven characters long
- Only send or upload photos and video you'd be happy to show a teacher or future employer
- If someone makes you feel uncomfortable, block them and tell a trusted adult
- Report directly to CEOP if something has happened online which has made you feel unsafe, scared or worried.
